#### Activity One:

We have been exploring plants and flowers. There are examples of nature and living things all around us.

**Complete the 'Scavenger Hunt' sheet** – you could look around your garden, a local park or countryside.

**Challenge:** using your own knowledge or the help of someone at home, write down the names of as many different plants and flowers that you can see.

#### Activity Two:

You have been practising labelling parts of plants.

**On the worksheet, 'Parts of Plants', match the labels to the correct parts of the diagram.**

You can use your own knowledge, the internet, somebody at home or a book to help you.

**Challenge:** write down two things that plants and flowers need to grow.

#### Activity Three:

There are many different types of plants and flowers. There are many different textures, shapes and colours in nature.

To practise your creative skills, **make a collage** using natural items you find outside. It can be of one of your interests, a flower or a picture or pattern of your choice. Look at the 'Plant and Flower Collage' sheet to help you.

**Challenge:** You are learning about symmetry in Maths. Try to make your collage symmetrical.
