What happens if I don't follow the rules?

If you choose not to follow the rules to **socially distance** yourself by at least two metres or to wash your hands when required, you will be sent home, as you will not be keeping yourself or others safe. During this pandemic, we all have a responsibility to keep ourselves and others safe.

Adults will remind you to wash your hands and will tell you if you are too close to them or another student.

You can also remind adults or other students if you feel they are too close to you.

What will I do with my mobile phone?

You will not be able to leave your phone in the office, therefore you will need to leave your mobile phone at home.

Will I need to bring my own packed lunch and snacks?

Yes please! The kitchen will remain closed so you will need to bring all food and drink that you will want for the day. Water will be available as usual, but you will need your own bottle from home.

What will happen at break and lunchtime?

You will still need to practise **social distancing** and sit away from each other when eating. When in corridors and outside you will need to stand away from other students and talk from a distance of two metres. You will see adults doing this as well. You will not be allowed to share items and there will be a strict no touching rule.

What work will I be doing?

You will be completing the work set by your teachers that is already on our website. The staff working with you will support your learning activities. Laptops and iPads will also be available for you to use.


Will I be working with different students?

Yes, you will be working in a classroom with students from different year groups and different classes, however, we will have enough staff so groups will be very small. If you need time on your own that can be arranged.

Will I be in my usual classrooms?

You will be in some but not all of them. We will be using just a few rooms. The Hall, Dining Room, Student Support and Rooms 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 9 and 10 will be open. You will also have access to the field at the back of school and parts of the playground.

All of the rooms that you will be able to use will have squares taped onto the floor. This will help us all to remember to socially distance and keep safely apart from each other.



Will I see my friends?

You might see some of your friends. We cannot guarantee this. When in school you will be in a class of 4 students. You will remain with these students, eat lunch and have break together. You will remain in a 'bubble' and will not mix with students or staff in another 'bubble'. You will be given a map of the areas of school you can use. You must stay in the areas identified.

Do I need my own equipment?

You will be given your own brand new stationery and sensory tools. These must remain on your desk and only be used by you. Please do not bring any equipment from home.




PARENTS

CORONAVIRUS

Has not gone away!

As a school we are trying to provide a safe space for you to return to and for staff to work in.

DO NOT come to school if you have any of these symptoms.

You must stay at home!

Will my transport route be the same?

Your route may be different and there may be different students on your bus. The times that you are picked up and dropped off might also change.

What happens when I arrive at school?

A register will be taken on the bus as usual. When the doors open you will step off the bus, one at a time, and a member of staff will gel your hands and take your temperature. All staff and students will have their temperature taken in case someone has a fever. Anyone with a temperature of 37.8c or above will need to go home.

Once your temperature has been checked, you will be met by the adults working with you. They will take you to your classroom and you'll be ready to start your day.

Will I have to wash my hands when I arrive in school?

Yes, you will also need to wash your hands or use anti-bacterial hand gel before each activity, before eating and at any other transition points throughout the day. There are temporary handwashing stations around school and in classrooms.



Will I have to wear a facemask?

Some staff and students might want to wear a facemask. This is okay, however it is not compulsory.

Will I have to wear my school uniform?

Yes, you will be expected to wear full school uniform. It is advised that when you get home, you remove your uniform and it is washed straightaway.

Can I go for a walk if I need to?

Yes, if you need a rest break that will be fine. Staff will tell you where you are allowed to go.

Will I be allowed to sit next to other students?

No, not right next to other students. In line with government expectations, we will be **socially distancing**. This means you will sit at a desk on your own and at least two metres away from another student. Adults will remain at least two metres from you and each other.

Will my teachers be the same as before?

Some staff will not be in school. You might be working with staff that you have not worked with often but you know most staff anyway.

Will my timetable follow the normal times of the school day?

Yes, we will try to keep to the normal structure of the school day. There might be some delay depending on transport and the route it has to take.
